Prerequisites

- 1) You should have ArcGIS Pro installed in your laptop. If you have any issue in this regard, please reach out to the helpdesk team.
- You should have a user on discomap portal (<u>https://portal.discomap.eea.europa.eu</u>). If you don't have one, please reach out to helpdesk.
- 3) You should have privileges to use the appropriate ArcGIS Pro license level. If you cannot open ArcGIS pro with portal license as shown blow, please reach out to the helpdesk or the GIS system admins.

To connect to ArcGIS Pro from your own laptop please follow the below steps.

 Open ArcGIS Pro, you should see a screen like the following. This sign in screen can only be used if user would like to connect to ArcGS Pro using ArcGIS Online license, which is not our case. According user should define discomap portal in ArcGIS Pro to connect to it as a license endpoint for ArcGIS Pro. To do so Click on **Configure Licensing** link at the bottom of the screen.

 - Click **Ok**, this should restart ArcGIS Pro
